

2010 Concert Logistics

- Any player who is more than 100 miles from Letterkenny can claim an overnight allowance of €30 towards accommodation.
- Any player more than 150 miles from Tralee can claim two nights accommodation.
- Each band that has a group of players of more than six may nominate two adults who will receive the same allowance as the players.
- Players are asked to report to An Grianán Theatre Letterkenny at 12.00 p.m. on February 20th.
- Refreshments will be available in the Theatre during the day (water, snacks, minerals) and a light meal of finger food will be supplied to all players at 5.00 p.m. This will be FREE to all performers and band mentors.
- Players are asked to be ready in uniform for 6.30 p.m. NYPB polo shirt (supplied free on the day) and own band kilt.
- Concert will start at 7.30 p.m. sharp and will finish by 9.30 p.m. sharp.
- **Please encourage as many members of your bands and families to attend. It is a 350 seat theatre.**
- Expense forms should be submitted by band secretaries except in the case of where an individual band member is playing in the NYPB .
- Expense forms should be submitted to Paddy Cronin on the day of the concert where possible and a cheque will be issued .
- Expenses forms will be available at registration.
- Also taking part in the concert this year are the Letterkenny & District Pipe Band (World Champions Grade 4A in 2009) ; The Manorcunningham Pipe Band (All Ireland Champions Grade 3B in 2009) ; Thiepval Memorial Pipe Band (World Champions Grade 5 in 2009 and All Ireland Champions Grade 5 in 2009) .
